



Apolytikion of Sun. after Epiphany

At Your Baptism in the Jordan, O Lord, * worship of the Trinity was revealed, * for the Father's voice bore witness to You, * calling You His 'beloved Son,' * and the Spirit in the form of a dove confirmed the truth of these words. * O Christ God, Who appeared and enlightened the world, glory to You!

Kontakion of Sun. after Epiphany

You have appeared today to the inhabited earth, * and Your light, O Lord has been marked upon us * who with knowledge sing Your praise. * You have come, You are made manifest, * the Light that no man can approach.

Saints and Feasts

Sunday after Epiphany January 12 | *Tatiana the Martyr of Rome*

Reading Saint Tatiana was the daughter of a most distinguished consul of Rome. She became a deaconess of the Church, and for her confession of the Faith of Christ, she endured many torments. As she was suffering, angels punished her tormentors with the same torments they inflicted on her, until they cried out that they could no longer endure the scourges invisibly brought upon them. She was beheaded during the reign of Alexander Severus (111-135).

Apolytikion of Martyr Tatiana O Lord Jesus, unto Thee Thy lamb doth cry with a great voice: O my Bridegroom, Thee I love; and seeking Thee, I now contest, and with Thy baptism am

crucified and buried. I suffer for Thy sake, that I may reign with Thee; for Thy sake I die, that I may live in Thee: accept me offered out of longing to Thee as a spotless sacrifice. Lord, save our souls through her intercessions, since Thou art great in mercy.

Kontakion of Martyr Tatiana Thou didst shine resplendently, Martyr Tatiana, in thy sacred sufferings and in the crimson of thy blood, soaring to Heaven like a fair dove; hence ever pray Christ for all them that honour thee.

Τατιανή Μάρτυς Η Αγία Μάρτυς Τατιανή καταγόταν άπὸ τὴ Ρώμη καὶ ἔζησε κατὰ τὴν έποχὴ τοῦ αὐτοκράτορα Αλεξάνδρου τοῦ Σεβήρου (222 – 235 μ.Χ.). Ο πατέρας της εἶχε διατελέσει ὕπατος.

Η Αγία Τατιανή εἶχε τὸ ἐκκλησιαστικὸ ἀξίωμα τῆς διακόνισσας καὶ στὴν ὑμνολογία παρίσταται ὡς μαθήτρια τῶν Αγίων Αποστόλων Πέτρου καὶ Παύλου. Η ἐπισημότητα τῆς καταγωγῆς της καὶ ὁ ἔνθεος ζῆλος μὲ τὸν ὁποῖο ἐκτελοῦσε τὰ διακονικά της καθήκοντα, ἔδωσαν στὴν Τατιανὴ περιφανὴ θέση μεταξὺ τῶν Χριστιανῶν. Καὶ οὶ Εθνικοὶ ὅμως εἶχαν ἀκούσει περὶ αὐτῆς καὶ δὲν μποροῦσαν νὰ δεχθοῦν τὸ γεγονὸς ὅτι μία τέτοια γυναίκα καταφρονοῦσε τὶς κοσμικὲς βλέψεις καὶ περιφρονοῦσε τὰ εἴδωλα, γιὰ νὰ ὑπηρετεῖ μὲ τόση αὐταπάρνηση τοὺς Χριστιανοὺς καὶ νὰ κηρύττει τὸ Εὐαγγέλιο τοῦ Κυρίου. Ởταν, ἐπὶ Σεβήρου, διατάχθηκε δίωξη τῶν Χριστιανῶν, ἡ Τατιανὴ συνελήφθη καὶ ἐπειδὴ διεκήρυττε τὴν πίστη της στὸν Χριστό, τὴν ὁδήγησαν μπροστὰ στὸ βασιλέα καὶ μαζὶ μὲ αὐτὸν είσῆλθε σὲ ἔνα είδωλολατρικὸ ναό. Εκεῖ ὅμως ἡ Αγία, μὲ μιὰ θερμὴ προσευχὴ στὸ Χριστό, συντάραξε τὰ ξόανα (τὰ ξύλινα ἀγάλματα) τῶν θεοτήτων τῆς είδωλολατρίας καὶ τὰ γκρέμισε στὸ δάπεδο. Γιὰ τὸν λόγο αὐτὸ τὴν ὑπέβαλαν σὲ βασανιστήρια. Τὴν κτύπησαν καὶ μὲ σιδερένια νύχια τῆς ξέσκισαν τὰ βλέφαρα. Επειτα τὴν κρέμασαν καὶ τῆς ξύρισαν τὸ κεφάλι. Ακολούθως τὴν ἔριξαν πάνω σὲ φωτιά, άλλὰ δὲν ἔπαθε τίποτα. Κατόπιν τὴν ἔριξαν σὲ πεινασμένα ἄγρια θηρία, άλλὰ αὐτὰ δὲν τόλμησαν νὰ τὴν βλάψουν. Υστερα ἀπὸ ὅλα αὐτά, οὶ εἰδωλολάτρες, ἔκοψαν τὴν Τίμια κεφαλὴ καὶ κατ' αὐτὸν τὸν τρόπο ἡ Αγία εἰσῆλθε μὲ τὸ στέφανο τῆς δόξας στὴ χαρὰ τοῦ Κυρίου της.

Απολυτίκιον Τατιανής Μάρτυρος Η αμνάς σου Ιησού, κράζει μεγάλη τή φωνή Σέ νυμφίε μου ποθώ, καί σέ ζητούσα αθλώ, καί συσταυρούμαι, καί συνθάπτομαι τώ βαπτισμώ σου, καί πάσχω διά σέ, ως βασιλεύσω συν σοί, καί θνήσκω υπέρ σού, ίνα καί ζήσω εν σοί αλλ' ως θυσίαν άμωμον, προσδέχου τήν μετά πόθου τυθείσάν σοι, Αυτής πρεσβείαις, ως ελεήμων σώσον τάς ψυχάς ημών.

ENTRANCE HYMN. Come, let us worship and bow down before Christ. Save us, O Son of God, risen from the dead. We sing to You, Alleluia.

RESURRECTIONAL APOLYTIKION When the women disciples of the Lord heard the Angel joyously proclaim the resurrection, they cast aside the ancestral verdict, and boasting in glory they said to the Apostles, "Death has been despoiled! Christ God has risen, granting the great mercy to the world!"

APOLYTIKION OF THE FEAST When You were baptized in the River Jordan, O Lord, it was revealed that God is worshiped in Trinity. For the voice of the Father, who had begotten You, also bore witness to You, calling You "beloved Son," and the Spirit, in the form of a dove, confirmed that what was said is true. In Your epiphany, O Christ God, You appeared and illumined the world. Glory to You!

MEMORIAL HYMN Remember, O Lord, as you are good, your servants and forgive whatever sin they have committed in life, for no one is without sin except you the mighty One; and grant rest to them, who have been removed from among us.

FOR SAINT GEORGE As the one renowned for setting captives free and for defending those in poverty, the physician of the sick and the champion of emperors, great and victorious Martyr George, intercede with Christ our God, beseeching Him to save our souls.

KONTAKION You revealed yourself today on earth, O Master, * and Your light was stamped on us, who in the knowledge of the truth, * O Lord, extol Your epiphany. * You came; You revealed yourself, O unapproachable Light.

THE CHERUBIC Let us, who mystically represent the Cherubim and who sing the thrice-holy hymn to the life creating Trinity, now lay aside every worldly care. So that we may receive the King of all.

HYMN TO THE THEOTOKOS It is truly right to bless you, Theotokos, ever blessed, most pure, and Mother of our God. More honorable than the Cherubim, and beyond compare more glorious than the Seraphim, without corruption you gave birth to God the Logos. We magnify you, the true Theotokos.

THE EPISTLE READING

The reading is from St. Paul's Letter to the Ephesians 4:7-13

BRETHREN, grace was given to each of us according to the measure of Christ's gift. Therefore it is said, "When he ascended on high he led a host of captives, and he gave gifts to men." (in saying, "He ascended," what does it mean but that he had also descended into the lower parts of the earth? He who descended is he who also ascended far above all the heavens, that he might fill all things.) And his gifts were that some should be apostles, some prophets, some evangelists, some pastors and teachers, to equip the saints for the work of ministry, for building up the body of Christ, until we all attain to the unity of the faith and of the knowledge of the Son of God, to mature manhood, to the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ.

Πρὸς Έφεσίους 4:7-13 τὸ ἀνάγνωσμα

Α΄δελφοί, ἐνὶ ἐκάστῳ ἡμῶν έδόθη ἡ χάρις κατὰ τὸ μέτρον τῆς δωρεᾶς τοῦ Χριστοῦ. Διὸ λέγει, Α΄ναβὰς είς ὕψος ἡχμαλώτευσεν αίχμαλωσίαν, καὶ ἔδωκεν δόματα τοῖς ἀνθρώποις. Τὸ δέ, Α΄νέβη, τί έστιν εί μὴ ὅτι καὶ κατέβη πρῶτον είς τὰ κατώτερα μέρη τῆς γῆς; Ο΄ καταβάς, αὐτός έστιν καὶ ὁ ἀναβὰς ὑπεράνω πάντων τῶν οὐρανῶν, ἴνα πληρώσῃ τὰ πάντα. Καὶ αὐτὸς ἔδωκεν τοὺς μὲν ἀποστόλους, τοὺς δὲ προφήτας, τοὺς δὲ εὐαγγελιστάς, τοὺς δὲ ποιμένας καὶ διδασκάλους, πρὸς τὸν καταρτισμὸν τῶν ἀγίων, είς ἔργον διακονίας, είς οἰκοδομὴν τοῦ σώματος τοῦ Χριστοῦ· μέχρι καταντήσωμεν οὶ πάντες είς τὴν ἐνότητα τῆς πίστεως καὶ τῆς έπιγνώσεως τοῦ υὶοῦ τοῦ θεοῦ, είς ἄνδρα τέλειον, είς μέτρον ἡλικίας τοῦ πληρώματος τοῦ Χριστοῦ.

THE GOSPEL READING

The Gospel According to Matthew 4:12-17

At that time, when Jesus heard that John had been arrested, he withdrew into Galilee; and leaving Nazareth he went and dwelt in Capernaum by the sea, in the territory of Zebulun and Naphtali, that what was spoken by the prophet Isaiah might be fulfilled: "The land of Zebulun and the land of Naphtali, toward the sea, across the Jordan, Galilee of the Gentiles, the people who sat in darkness have seen a great light, and for those who sat in the region and shadow of death light has dawned." From that time Jesus began to preach, saying, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand."


